

Graduate Application Video Submission

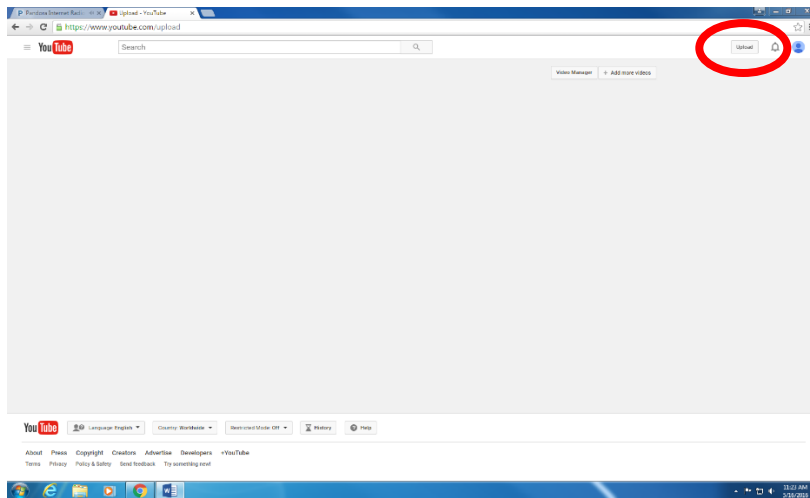
Each applicant must submit a 3 to 5-minute video recording of him or herself that includes the following:

1. A brief introduction of yourself
2. Why you want to become a speech-language pathologist
3. Where you see yourself professionally in 5-10 years
4. Why you feel Illinois State University's program is the right program for you

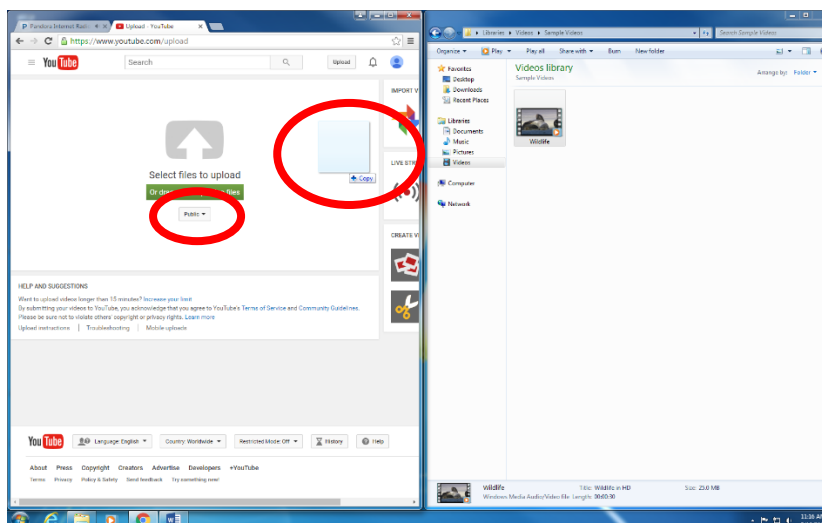
These video recordings should be uploaded to *youtube.com* as follows:

STEP ONE: Create your video and save it on your preferred device (flash drive, DVD, hard drive, etc.).

STEP TWO: Create an account or log on with an existing account to *youtube.com*. In the upper right hand corner, click on "UPLOAD".



STEP THREE: Drag the video clip from where it is saved to the YouTube window as shown in the following picture.



STEP FOUR: Keep your video privacy set to “UNLISTED” (as shown above; a private video will not be able to be viewed by the admissions committee) and click “DONE”

STEP FIVE: Submit your video through your CSDCAS Application

- Log on to CSDCAS
- Paste your YouTube video URL in the text box on the Questions section of the application
